1999
Dan Tiroke joined us as EMC technician and is still with us as commercial EMC engineer, with a specialism in radiated immunity.

2004
With customer demand we started moving into Military Testing, performing testing to DEFSTAN 59-411 and MIL 461.



2013
The new facility is complete and opened in early 2013. This is a transformation from our previously cramped facility of 2,000 square feet at Brickfield Lane, into Hursley EMC becoming the largest EMC facility, complete with the largest CISPR16 chamber, on the south coast.

2012
We managed to secure the perfect unit for Hursley EMC to move in to. 10,000 square feet, with huge ceiling height to allow full size CISPR16 chambers to be installed and space around to expand. We start the fitting out of Trafalgar Close with 2 CISPR16 Chambers and 3 smaller chambers for military testing.

2010
The first retiring director was Ian Kenney.

2008
Added a second smaller chamber on the first floor at Brickfield Lane, solely for military EMC to solve a lack of chamber space.

2006
Neil Constance joined, bringing a wealth of experience and enthusiasm to boost our military resource and capability. He is now senior EMC engineer and runs the military department.



2014
With the prevalence of radio devices in so many products now, we recruited Richard Pennell from Nokia to add technical expertise quickly to our low power radio testing. Richard is now lead engineer in the Radio section.

2015
We took on two apprentices, one in the commercial section and one in military, Dan White and Luke Marsh. Both are doing well at day release college and becoming valuable members of the team.

2016
With the Commercial work still expanding Ryan Craig joined us from one of our customers.

2017
Saw a rebranding of the original logo, and we also took on Callum Rice an additional apprentice in the military section. Callum is studying at the Gosport apprentice centre for his BTEC.

2018
Hursley EMC Services was acquired by the Eurofins Group and renamed Eurofins E&E Hursley Limited. New expansion and investment plans were finalised for a new 3M Fully Anechoic Room (FAR).
